Cancellations/ Enrollment Transfer

A \$20 nonrefundable registration fee is included in the tuition.

If LCT cancels the class for any reason, you will receive a full refund.

- If student cancels more than two weeks before class begins, student will receive a full refund, less the \$20 registration fee.
- If student cancels less than two weeks prior but before class begins, student will receive full credit towards another theatre school class during that fiscal year.
- If student cancels the day of or after class begins, a credit will be issued for 70% of the tuition.
- After the second class, no adjustments will be made.
- If you choose to transfer enrollment or switch a class for any reason, a \$15 processing fee will be charged.

Financial Aid

LCT's Financial Aid program is based solely on financial need. Financial Aid is awarded in 15%, 25%, or 50% tuition waivers. To obtain the form, visit the website or call the Education Department. The form is due 2 weeks prior to the first day of class and does not guarantee a spot in the class. Drawing FUNdamentals (everyone 13 and older)
