Touring Productions - a show that doesn't just perform here in Lexington! Our high school/college student actors during the summer and adult, professional actors during the school year travel to schools, libraries, and theatres all over Kentucky and beyond!

<u>Theatre for the Very Young</u> - a show designed for ages 2-5. These productions are perfect for first-time theatre goers!



### Other Opportunities

### **Theatre School**

Lexington Children's Theatre offers Theatre School classes throughout the year, in Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter sessions. Each course ends in a "sharing" that is attended by parents, grandparents, friends, and family. In a traditional year, over 1,600 children take a class at LCT, and over 4,200 family members attended sharings.

### Youth Companies

LCT currently has two youth acting companies, Company B, comprised of high-school aged students, and Junior Company, comprised of middle school students. Last year, there were 65 participants in these programs. Each group has a year-end performance that is attended by friends and families.

### **Shooting Stars Youtheatre**

LCT's Satellite Theatre, Shooting Stars Youtheatre, is based in Eastern Kentucky and offers theatre programming to youth in Rowan and Elliott counties at low- to no-cost.
