

1.	Tyrannosaurus Rex. Cannivore. Size. 13-20 feet tan and 40 feet
	long. Small arms. Lived during the Cretaceous period. Tail helped it run at
	speeds of 15 mph.
2.	Brachiosaurus. Long neck. Lived during the mid to late Jurassic
	period. Lived on mostly flat land due to its size. Believed to have traveled in
	herds. Ate vegetation.
3.	Velociraptor. Sickle-shaped claw. Small and fast. Lived during the
	end of the Cretaceous period. The most birdlike dinosaur discovered.
4.	Stegosaurus. Lived during late Jurassic period. Herbivore. Very
	small brain. 30 feet long. Plates on back called scutes.
5.	Triceratops. Three-horned dinosaur. Lived during late Cretaceous
	period. Comparable to size of African Elephant. Herbivore. 800 teeth. Frill

acted as body armor.
